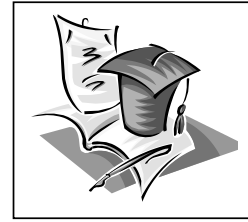




## Suffolk County Police Memorial Fund 2017 ACTIVE DUTY SCHOLARSHIP



Applications are now being accepted for the **2017 Suffolk County Police Memorial Fund Active Duty Scholarship**. This scholarship is given as a secondary purpose of the Memorial Fund to encourage education. It is given in memory of those police officers in Suffolk County who have given their lives while in the performance of their duty.

To apply, you must be a high school senior planning to enroll in a recognized program of undergraduate study **and** be the dependent child of a Suffolk County Police Officer, or a participating East End Department, who is employed by the Department as well as a contributing member of the Suffolk County Police Memorial Fund on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

The Memorial Fund will award three \$1,000 scholarships. Winners will be chosen from those who meet the criteria set forth below. These scholarships are renewable for all 4 years of undergraduate study, as long as the recipient maintains a minimum 2.5 cumulative average.

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of character, school involvement, community service and a 500-word essay depicting life in a law enforcement family. Each of these categories will be considered in determining the award recipients.

To apply you must submit a packet containing **ALL** of the materials listed below, no later than **March 21, 2017**:

1. A completed and signed application
2. Three letters of recommendation from teachers, coaches, advisors or employers
3. **Essay:** Write a 500 word essay depicting where you see yourself in ten years.  
-or- a 500 word essay depicting life in a law enforcement family.

Your completed application packet should be sent to the following address and **MUST** be received by no later than **March 21, 2017**. Due to time restraints, there will be **NO** exceptions to the deadline date.
